Application for Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

Early Years Pupil Premium is additional funding for early years providers to improve education for disadvantaged 3 and 4 year olds

You may be eligible to apply for EYPP if you are in receipt of at least one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance (ESA)
- Child Tax Credit and/or Working Tax Credit and have an income of less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on, which is paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax credit.
- Universal Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
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You may also be eligible if your child:

- Has been in local authority care for one day or more in England or Wales
- Has been adopted from care in England or Wales
- Has left care under a Special Guardianship Order or a Residence Order in England or Wales.

Please complete the attached form and return to the school office if you are happy for us to check your EYPP eligibility on your behalf.
