Summer 2026 Term Junior Club Bookings

Parents/carers should book and pay for clubs on ParentPay. It is advisable to double check in advance that you can login successfully. There are links to the ParentPay login page on the school website Home Page and under 'Quick Links' - 'Online Payments'. Please note that clubs are not bookable without payment. Once you have booked and made payment, your place is confirmed. Clubs are due to start on **Monday 20th April 2026**.

Pupil Premium Grant

If your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant, they are entitled to one free club per child. These should be booked with the school office or emailing the clubs co-ordinator (clubsandbookings@honeywell.wandsworth.sch.uk) as soon as possible as they are subject to availability. Any further club bookings should be made on ParentPay during the final booking period and are charged at the standard rate.

Initial Booking Period. ONE CLUB ONLY PER CHILD FOR PAID CLUBS.

In order to ensure as many children as possible are able to enrol; one club only per child may be booked on a first-come, first-served basis from approximately **2pm Tuesday 24th March 2026**. At around this time, clubs will gradually appear on ParentPay. This should take a few minutes so please refresh if you cannot find your preferred club. To avoid disappointment, prompt booking is advised. This initial booking period will only be available until the end of **2pm Thursday 26th March 2026**. After this the booking system will not be available for a period whilst bookings are checked. In cases where more than one club has been booked per child, additional places will be randomly cancelled. **It will not be possible to rebook any cancelled club(s).**

Final Booking Period

The booking system will re-open from about **2pm Tuesday 31st March 2026**. Again, clubs should gradually appear on the system. At this stage there are no restrictions on the number of clubs that may be booked.

Waiting Lists

When a club is full, it is usually advisable to look for another option. However, once a club is fully booked on ParentPay, you may decide to email the Clubs Co-ordinator (clubsandbookings@honeywell.wandsworth.sch.uk) to register your child's interest. All emails will be noted but it will not be possible to reply as the club booking/preparation period can be very hectic. We will only respond in the unlikely event of a vacancy.

Payment

All club payments must be made by debit/credit card when booking clubs via ParentPay. Clubs cannot be booked without making payment, recent payments and an option to view payment history is available on ParentPay.

Further Information

Please note that the Infant and Junior Schools have separate booking systems. You will need to complete payments for booking/s in one school before starting to book clubs in the other. Once you have booked on ParentPay, your child's club place is confirmed. Whilst you may receive an automatic email receipt generated by the booking system, there will be no further emails from the school. All relevant club details will be available when booking the clubs and will remain visible on ParentPay for reference.

Having booked clubs, please ensure you include any information that should be available on the club registers. This must be re-done each term to ensure club providers are informed. Necessary information might include notes on medical conditions or SEN support guidance, permission to walk home alone after club or requests for the club provider to deliver your child to School's Out Club afterwards.

Unfortunately, once the booking and payment is received, we can't offer refunds as participant numbers are used to assess club viability and confirm coach/tutor numbers. If demand for any club is insufficient, we reserve the right to cancel. By applying for a club, you are agreeing to your child adhering to the club rules.

Subject to availability, children eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant may book one free club.

CLUB RULES

By applying for your child to join a club you are confirming that you have read and accepted all applicable rules.

- All sessions must be paid for in advance. Club bookings are not valid until payment is received. Children will not be admitted to the lesson/club session at the start of term, if the school office has not received payment for the club in full. If you have any outstanding debts with the school office these must be paid in full before your child can join any club.
- If parents are not in a position to pay the full amount the School may be able to provide a subsidy. Please make all requests for financial support in writing and hand to the relevant Head of each School before the club booking system opens. Please explain your circumstances at the time of making the application. If your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant, one club per child is free. This does not require clearance from the Head but should be booked with the school office.
- Please ensure the school office has up-to-date emergency contacts and medicines. Each term, any medical notes on your child must be emailed to the clubs co-ordinator before they participate in any club.
- Children must be collected promptly. Many providers have other lessons to attend to after the club and there is no provision for childcare once the club session is over. Please note that the school office shuts at 5.00 pm and children are not allowed to wander around the school unattended. If your child remains at school at 5.00 pm and the school staff have explored every possible contact on file trying to get your child collected, the next option will be to contact the school leadership team: in some cases social services. Children who are collected late consistently will be asked to leave the club. No refund will be given in these circumstances.
- The Club Co-ordinator will do their very best to make sure that you are notified of deadlines but it remains a parent/carers responsibility to make bookings and payments on time and check their child's own schedule for clashes.
- If your child needs one; please only send a very small, healthy snack. This will allow the clubs to begin promptly.
- Disruptive, bullying or unsociable behaviour will not be tolerated. Children who are persistently disruptive will be asked to leave the club. No refund will be given.
- If a club is cancelled due to bad weather (except in the case where the entire school is closed due to extreme weather) the school will work with the club provider to ensure the cancelled session is replaced or that session refunded.
- Once a club place has been successfully booked and paid for, no refunds can be given.
- If your child fails to attend a club, no refund will be issued for that session and or subsequent sessions they fail to attend. Unfortunately, if a school trip or activity clashes with a club session, no refunds can be given.
- To enable participants to fully focus on the activity, parent/carers are asked to refrain from attending club sessions.
- Every effort has been made to ensure your child has an enjoyable experience with a qualified provider during school clubs. If you have any concerns/queries or complaints regarding your child and their club, please contact the Club Co-ordinator in the first instance. Please do not interrupt the clubs when in session.

If the Club Co-ordinator fails to address those concerns or you remain unsatisfied then please raise this in writing with the relevant Head Teacher. If the matter still remains unresolved then the Head teachers will raise your concern, query or complaint with the Board of Governors at the earliest opportunity.
