

Our topic this half of term is **Superheroes!** We hope this topic web will give you some idea of all of the lovely activities your child will enjoy this half term.

### Communication, Language and Literacy

The children will:

Revise and consolidate their phonic knowledge including all taught Phase 2 and Phase 3 GPS and tricky words.  
Write imaginative stories about their own superheroes.  
Talk 4 Writing 'We're Going to Find the Monster'.  
During this half term the children will continue to practise using a capital letter at the beginning of their writing, finger spaces  
in-between their words and a full stop at the end of the sentence.  
Develop their independence when writing before going to Year One and complete a collection of independent writing pieces to be passed to their Year One teacher.

### Mathematics

The children will:

Revise and consolidate ordering, recognising and writing the numbers 0–20 and beyond.  
Practise counting in 2s by counting pairs of socks and gloves and 5s by putting the numbers on a Clive 5 headband.  
Investigate different ways of adding and taking away e.g. counting on, using objects, using a number line and mental strategies.  
Revise sharing and doubling  
Consolidate their understanding of 2D and 3D shapes  
Continue to use mathematical reasoning to solve some simple worded problems

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will:

Think about what makes them a 'superhero', for example what different talents they have.  
Think about 'differences': all superheroes have different talents!  
Think about 'changes' in circle times, preparing them for the new routines of Year 1.  
Meet their Year 1 teacher and see their new classroom.  
Think about 'differences': all superheroes have different talents!



### Physical Development

The children will:

Learn about a 'superhero's diet' by learning about the importance of keeping healthy and those things which contribute to this.  
Recognise the changes that happen to their bodies when they are active.  
Take part in 'Gymnastics' with Michaela during indoor P.E. sessions  
Take part in our Reception sports day.  
Take part in a Wimbledon Tennis day.

### Understanding of the World

The children will:

Explore a range of materials to find out if they stretch, if they are magnetic or if they are sticky.

I can record and compare the weather during different seasons.



### Expressive Arts and Design

The children will:

Use their imagination to design their very own superhero costume.  
Make their own superhero masks and accessories using a variety of different materials.  
Design their own superhero logo.  
Turn themselves into superheroes with dressing up opportunities in our class 'Superhero Headquarters'
