

Honeywell Infant School Appeals Process for 2026

If your child is not offered a place in Reception at Honeywell Infant School, you have a right to appeal the decision to an independent appeals panel. If you wish to appeal, you will need to complete and submit the online appeal form which you can find by visiting <https://www.wandsworth.gov.uk/schools-and-admissions/admissions/school-admissions-appeals/>. The appeals process is outlined below. Parents will need to submit any supporting evidence in advance of the appeals hearing. Any evidence provided by an appellant after the set deadline may not be taken into account by the Panel.

- Appeal forms for a reception class place should be returned to the Appeals Service by no later than **18th May 2026**.
- Primary Appeals relating to entry into Reception in September 2025 will be heard from **22nd June 2026 to 17th July 2026** inclusive. Hearings will not be scheduled during half term, weekends or bank holidays.
- Appeals lodged after 18th May 2026 will be heard within 40 school days of the appeal deadline or 30 school days of the appeal being received, whichever is the later date.
- Appellants will be sent notification by the Appeals Service notifying them of their hearing date no later than ten school days in advance of their appeal hearing.
- The Appeals Service will send the appeals papers to parents, the admission authority and the appeal panel seven working days in advance of the hearing date.
- Appellants will be asked to submit any additional evidence relating to their appeal by no later than 8:00am, three working days prior to the hearing. The Appeals Service will circulate without delay to all parties to the hearing any additional information received.
- The decision letter will be sent within five school days after the appeal hearing wherever possible or as soon as possible thereafter.
